

Italy is one of the world leaders in packaging machinery, with a world market share of 25,5%.


In 2018 the sector's turnover totaled more than 7 billion euro, with exports accounting for around 80% of total turnover.





THE ITALIAN PACKAGING SECTOR

With sales of more than 6 billion euro, the Italian automatic packaging machinery sector is a dynamic Italian industry.

It is one of the Italian sectors with the highest export propensity (more than 80%) and consists of some 200-250 industrial-sized companies, along with around 300 manufacturing units with artisanal characteristics.

Italy has a world-leading industry that competes with German manufacturers for the international leadership position. In fact, more than 50% of all automatic packaging machinery sold worldwide is either Italian or German.

The Italian automatic packaging machinery industry's leadership position is based on four essential factors: a high level of technology and product quality; an extremely high level of customization and operating flexibility of machinery; rapid after-sales support in all world markets; and a high degree of competitiveness based on the combination of large integrated groups and highly specialized small and medium-sized enterprises that, as a whole, offer a full range of machinery for all types of products.

The companies are predominately based in the regions of Emilia-Romagna (home to the highest concentration of sector companies anywhere in the world), Lombardy, Piedmont and Veneto, together accounting for more than 80% of the sector's companies. The manufacturing center is in the so-called "Packaging Valley" in the province of Bologna.

Most of the packaging machinery produced goes to the food sector (which accounts for around 60% of the industry's turnover) and pharmaceutical, cosmetics and toiletries (just under 25%), and various other sector, particularly tobacco, where the Italian machinery industry has a long tradition, chemicals/petrochemicals and tissues.

Today, more then ever it is essential that manufacturers who look to maintain their respective leadership have the essential solutions and know-how which Italian companies can readily provide, to help them maintain long term growth and prosperity.
