

Italy is one of the leading global manufacturers and exporters of industrial technology, including machinery and equipment for earthmoving, construction and mining.

Italy's equipment has a reputation for being technologically advanced, of superior quality and durability and extremely reliable. These features are particularly well received in North America In 2022, Canada, the Usa and Mexico, jointly, bought over €17.5 billion worth of industrial and capital goods from Italy, representing 1/4 of Italy's total exports to North America.

Canada is the 19th destination market for Italian industrial technology while Italy is Canada's 8th largest supplier of machinery and equipment with €2 billion imported in 2022. In terms of earthmoving and construction equipment, Italy's exports to Canada totalled € 12 million, ranking Italy 10th amongst Canada's major suppliers. Dumpers, dump trucks, derricks, cranes and

works trucks fitted with a crane accounted for over 40% of Canada' sector imports from Italy.

According to Unacea, the Italian Construction Equipment Association, in 2022 Italy produced almost 26 thousand units of earthmoving, mining and construction equipment.

The main machinery categories assembled in Italy being crawler excavators wheeled excavators, wheel loaders, aws backhoe loaders, rigid backhoe loaders, mini excavators, skid steer loaders, track loaders, articulated dumpers, rollers, cold planers and finishers. The mini excavators accounted for approximately 50% of the machinery produced in Italy in 2022.
